This popular networking event, for young professionals* in the water quality industry (operators, engineers, vendors, etc.), will highlight the design and operations of the Stratford, CT Water Pollution Control Facility (WPCF).

The Stratford, CT WPCF is an 11.5-MGD facility, which was upgraded in 2009 to a 4-stage biological nutrient removal (BNR) process to comply with the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's (CT DEEP) long-term nitrogen plan for Long Island Sound. The tour will include: influent mechanically cleaned bar screens, 4-stage biological nutrient removal process with real-time monitoring, UV disinfection system, and a plant-wide SCADA system. A highlight of this tour will be the dynamic process control for the supplemental carbon (glycerol) feed system to the 2nd anoxic zones for enhanced denitrification. *New professionals to the water industry will be given priority for the tour.*

Following the tour—join us at Two Roads Brewery for networking, food and drinks.

This networking event is open to both organization members and non-members. New professionals to the water industry will be given priority for the tour. Everyone is welcome at the brewery. Registration is required whether attending one or both events. Friends and significant others are welcome. A valid ID will be required for entry to the brewery. Cost is \$15 per person.
