ecently, ASCE released their 2017 Infrastructure Report Card rating the nation's wastewater systems with a low grade of D+. Though years of facility and system upgrades have significantly reduced untreated releases of wastewater and improved wastewater overall, there is still much work to do on our aging infrastructure. Given the longevity of our infrastructure systems, repair and replacement of those systems must be done in a sustainable manner.
