- Stable/Level foundation
- Broken ladder usage
- Used as designed
- Top step usage





- Competent/Trained operators
- 3 year operator evaluation
- Unsafe & left in service
- Daily inspection







- Point of Operation, Nip Points, Rotating Parts, Fly Chips/Sparks
- Foundation Anchored
- Missing Guards





- Inadequacies in Affected Employee's knowledge
- Written certification of training
- Recognize hazards of falling
- Competent Person





- Substitute for fixed wiring
- Defective temp. cord
- Broken/Missing cover (panel/ outlet)
