was constructed in 1973. A major upgrade to the WWTF was completed in 1994 and since that time, several components of the facility have been upgraded and replaced with new, more efficient systems, including a dewatering system upgrade in 2012 and a disinfection system upgrade in 2016.

The facility provides conventional activated sludge secondary treatment that includes a step screen, grit separation chamber, six aeration basins, two secondary clarifiers, and a chlorine contact tank for seasonal disinfection with sodium hypochlorite.
