

 Extent of Nitrogen Removal Needed for Coastal Watersheds May Not Be Great Enough to Require a WW Treatment Plant




I/A System Use Under The Pleasant Bay Watershed Permit

I/A System Benefits for Ponds

 Fresh Water Ponds - Given The Number of Homes Requiring Septic Upgrades Around Each Pond, WWTPs are Not a Cost-Effective Option



SRF Funds for I/A Systems Issues and Questions

- Clarification on Funding for I/A systems adjacent to fresh-water ponds.
 - Compliant Title 5 systems that remove phosphorus
 - Phosphorus I/A systems with pilot/provisional approval
