




Wastewater Technology Fact Sheet **Fine Bubble Aeration**

DESCRIPTION

In wastewater treatment processes, aeration introduces air into a liquid, providing an aerobic environment for microbial degradation of organic matter. The purpose of acrition is two-fold: 1) to supply the required oxygen to the metabolizing microorganisms and 2) to provide mixing so that the






