



Terms of Use – PFAS Awareness Campaign Materials

The following terms of use apply to the five posters, one-page informational sheet, and bill stuffers (materials), created by New England Water Environment Association (NEWEA) and the Northeast Biosolids and Residuals Association (NEBRA) as part of their PFAS Awareness Campaign. The word “users” in the following terms refers to any individual who is granted permission to use the materials.

These materials were created for the sole purpose of promoting awareness and education regarding PFAS in our environment. The intended use of these materials includes publishing them on digital and print channels to reach intended audiences, specifically residents and elected officials of the six New England states. Any misuse of these materials and/or violation of the terms outlined below may result in NEWEA and NEBRA withdrawing consent for use of these materials.

1. **Permission:** Users must complete our [partnership agreement form](#) and/or receive written permission from a NEWEA and/or NEBRA staff member to download and share these materials.
 - a. A fee applies to gain permission to share these materials. Payment of this fee supports NEWEA and NEBRAs’ investment in creating these materials. Users can select the fee amount that is most appropriate to their organization’s size/sector. Only registered nonprofits and municipalities are exempt from this fee.
2. **License:** Users are granted a limited license to use these materials.
 - a. These materials can be used in perpetuity. Granted permission for use does not have an expiration date.
 - b. Users are prohibited from editing materials, including materials’ images, content, colors, layout, and/or design. The only permitted exception is adding user’s logo to the designated empty space and replacing the placeholder text with custom text on the one-page informational sheet and bill stuffers.
 - c. This license is exclusive to the user who is granted permission by NEWEA/NEBRA. The license does not extend to additional users. The only exception to this term is:
 - i. Employers. Employers and/or colleagues at user’s place of employment may also distribute these materials under the original user’s license.
3. **Ownership:** NEWEA and NEBRA retain sole ownership of these materials and should be credited as the creators whenever appropriate.



- a. NEWEA and NEBRA logos must remain on all materials.
4. **Resale:** These materials are not eligible for resale. Users are not permitted to generate revenue from these materials.
