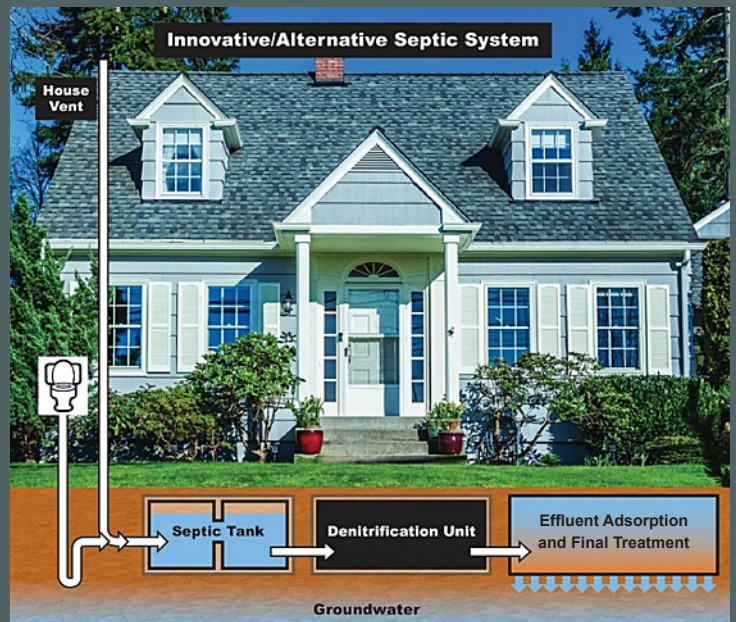

The objective of this webinar is to educate water, environmental, and health professionals on past progress and recent developments in distributed, enhanced I/A septic systems that produce effluent Nitrogen levels at or below 10mg/L. EPA's Southeast New England Program (SNEP) and the Atlantic and Coastal Environmental Sciences Division at EPA Office of Research and Development (ORD) conducted a three-day workshop in June to "Push the Ball Forward on I/A Septic Systems". The workshop included over 100 water professionals from around the country. EPA published over five hours of **workshop videos and a 49-page summary report** in early August.

This webinar will highlight key findings (including an update on the sensor challenge) and issues needing attention to accelerate adoption.

Who Should Attend

This should be of interest to health officers, water professionals, government officials and NGOs dealing with water quality issues relating to septic system effluent, particularly nitrogen overloading.
