The Cheshire Water Pollution Control Department protects public health by providing sanitary sewer service to approximately 5000 residential, commercial, and industrial properties. The Town's sewer system is comprised of 120 miles of sewer mains. These convey the sewage to the Cheshire Wastewater Treatment Plant. The flow to the plant is largely via a gravity collection system, in addition to nine pump stations located throughout town.
