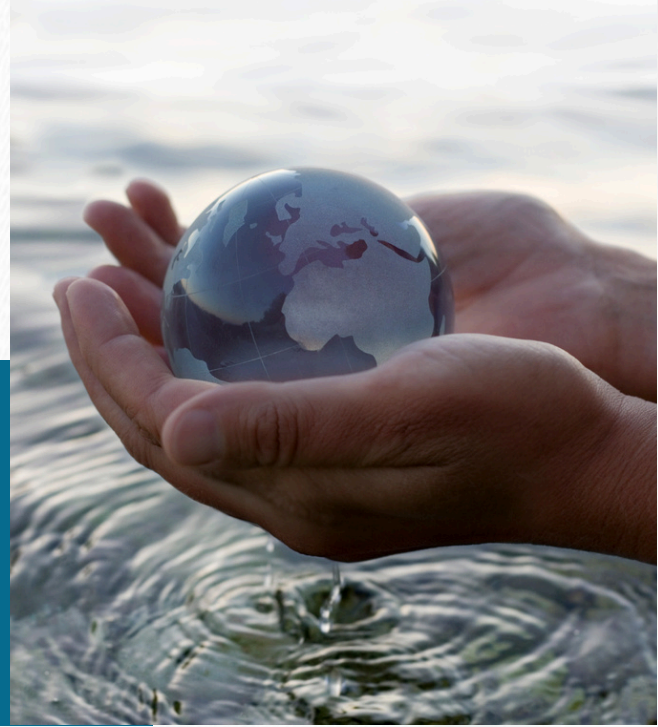


INFLOW PROGRAM

The New England Water Environment Association (NEWEA) is looking for the next generation of leaders in the clean water industry. The **I**ntroducing **F**uture **L**eaders to **O**pportunities in **W**ater (InFLOW) scholarship program aims to enhance the diversity and inclusion in the water workforce.



InFLOW, which is organized through NEWEA's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DE&I) Committee, helps to identify promising students and young professionals from underrepresented groups who are interested in careers in the water industry.

There are two potential paths that either current students or young professionals can apply for:

STEMPATH

Identifies scholars from historically underrepresented ethnic and racial groups who are enrolled in undergraduate or graduate STEM degree programs.

CAREERTECH

Partners with community based organizations to expose scholars in job readiness programs to the variety of rewarding career possibilities in water quality.

The InFLOW Program engages scholars and participating community based organizations to:

- Solidify their interest in and awareness of opportunities of work in the water sector
- Increase probability for employment and long term success working in water
